d. Photographs of objects if available: Photographs of objects are not available.

f. Objects sighted:

- (1) Number: Varying from one (1) to seven (7).
- (2) Shape: Undetermined.
- (3) Size: Undetermined.
- (4) Color: Shiny.
- (5) Speed: Varying from slow to very fast.
- (6) Heading: Objects did not hold any specific heading and were last seen heading west.
- (7) Maneuverability: Objects maneuvered horizontally but not vertically.
- (8) Altitude: Very high.
- (9) Sound: None.
- (10) Exhaust trail or not: None.

g. General remarks: Personnel from Medford Airways first sighted the objects and notified Medford Tower and Medford Radio. Personnel from Medford Radio used the theodolite to get a better look at the objects. Personnel from Medford Tower used binoculars and were able to distinguish wings on
