Mr. Wood telephonically contacted the Bureau at 12:50 a.m. 5/16/69 and spoke with SA Stephen F. McInerney, Special Investigative Division.

 Wood stated he is a former CIA Agent and wanted to report to the Director that recently he has been seeing flying objects. He requested that the Director call him on 5/16/69 concerning this matter. He was advised that Mr. Hoover would be unavailable.

From Wood's tone of voice it appeared he was intoxicated. He advised that he was recently discharged as a patient from the psycho ward of a Veteran's hospital.

Information in Bureau indices (66-3182-8679) indicates individual possibly identical with captioned subject called Bureau 5/1/69, at which time he rambled about numerous subjects and his speech indicated he had been drinking. At that time no record identifiable with Wood was located in Bureau files.

ACTION: For information. A check is being made with CIA to determine if they have a former agent identical with Wood.*
