BACKGROUND:

Letter ... forwarded to the Director ... telegram ... received from Robert ... which stated that he ... had the only authentic Japanese flying saucer ever recovered in this country. Mr. ... noted on the telegram, "To J. Edgar Hoover - Trust"

DETAILS:

This matter was discussed by Special Agent ... with the ... division of the Army, who advised that they had no information concerning any Japanese flying saucer having been recovered in the United States.

This matter was discussed with Colonel William J. Carpenter, ... who advised on April 27, 1949 that he had interested himself in the flying saucers and related subjects and that in so far as could be determined by him through his sources in the Air Force, which are excellent, there is no authentic information available concerning the phenomenon of the flying saucers. He advised he would check with the authorities at Wright Field to determine if any information is available concerning the recovery of a Japanese flying saucer.

Colonel Carpenter has now advised that there is no information available in any part of the Air Force as to the effect that any flying saucer or any ... been recovered in the United States. Colonel Carpenter stated that ... encountered in determining this fact ... fact ... known to him and ... from which possibly would receive a book answer.
