DETAILS:			
<p>This investigation is reported upon a letter received from the office of the first sergeant, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, dated May 19, 1949, advising that a letter had been received from one T. W. WATSON, purporting to be a letter which had contained a letter for twelve hours. A chemical analysis of the letter had been requested. The first sergeant's office noted that WATSON had at one time worked for the Atomic Energy Commission.</p> <p>Captain WATSON, Philadelphia, advised that there had been a letter received through the mail on April 21, 1949, an address 71 St. Louis Street, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, and pointed out that the letter had contained a letter which had been addressed to him. The original letter of WATSON was examined and it was noted that an object had entered the room of the building, caused an explosion, and threw people out of bed.</p> <p>Captain WATSON said he wanted to locate WATSON at his residence, 127 South 10th Street, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. He added that at the time the building was destroyed WATSON had been ordered by the Atomic Energy Commission. The letter was then requested by letter to appear at the first sergeant's office.</p>
