 Saturday, April 1, 1950 at about 6 P.M. I was
 driving north on Route 47 - west of Geneva, Illinois
 and a little north of St Charles, Illinois. Just
 ahead, thru the windshield I saw a silvery white
 object in the sky. It was traveling west at about
 the speed of an air plane. It was shaped like
 this . I was driving at 35 M.P.H. and
 slowed down to 20 M.P.H. to watch this object.
 It went behind a white cloud and I continued
 to watch but the object did not come out from
 behind the cloud as far as I could see.

Geneva is 35 miles west of Chicago, and just
 north of Chicago is the Glenview Airport, operated I
 believe by the Navy. The Saturday Evening
 Post carried an article sometime ago about
 flying saucers and it said to report something
 like the above to the F.B.I.
