Dear Mr. Hoover:

The motive of this letter is a sincere effort to help you  
analyze waste of life, time and money. It is written with full  
respect to your special work, and to the ability of this  
country's scientific experts.

Although your responsibility may not be directly connected  
with the intended text of this letter, I sincerely hope that  
you will consider the possibilities, and forward the suggestions  
to the proper authorities concerned.

For the past five years the general public has read, and daily  
has newspaper articles related to the "Flying Saucers", and  
believing the same trend of thought have ignored recent re-  
ports made by persons of undoubted experience and intelligence.

The possibilities of this earth being visited by beings from  
outer space have been lightly suggested by some, while others  
believe the "objects" being in some motion on this earth.  
Granted that some such objects do exist, it is not  
to be expected that we, nor any other nation, could  
to use, in time of war, such aerial means as have been re-  
ported by the balloon experts connected with General Mills, Inc.

I am sure that these suggestions will bear closer in-  
vestigation and that they are entirely probable. Similar to  
Columbus and the egg - they may not have been given the con-  
sideration.

These "objects" or unidentified objects (not to be confused  
with our controlled balloons, etc.) are in all prob-  
ability operated by the "objects" (unidentified, and con-  
trolled, entities) and the only energy (partially electrically)  
As soon as they probably carry a potential charge which is used  
our investigation. The aerial objects approaching the earth to
