- 3. A saucer landed at 4:30 a.m., September 30, 1954, at Rotunda Drive and Southfield (Detroit) with strange greenish men in brown uniforms.
- 4. Unseen psychic forces (no further explanation.)

Mr. WILLARD said that a group met at his home October 24, 1954, consisting of:

MARXER said there would be landings in Detroit in October, but she could be wrong. Before the meeting started, LUCY RAMBO called, saying, she was not coming and was resigning.
