Bulletin," which contains articles about flying saucers. Wold advised he answered an advertisement in a magazine and subscribed to this publication for one year, at a cost of \$3.00. Wold further advised that in his opinion, the publication slurred and criticized the U. S. Air Force and officials of the U. S. Air Force.

No action is contemplated in this matter by this Bureau.
