Washington. BARKER advised a Postal Agent of the Fifth DIO
Group at Fort McClellan that about five months ago he looked
over a list of names and their addresses when he visited the
office of the Chief Postal Officer, Department of the Army,
Washington, D. C.

The Seattle office is requested to ascertain who
lives at 5108 Tindley Street, Seattle, Wash., and
whether this address has any connection with a mail stop
the Russian Consul.
