Additional instructions for the field or instruction in the FBI Handbook or manuals relative to flying sensors.

On 10-2-59, it was pointed out that our policy concerning unclassified flying objects is to conduct an investigation but immediately refer facts to the Air Force (NY 100-100000, 10-1-59); that SAC Letter Number 100-100000-100000, reiterated this policy and set out details by which the Air Force to be obtained when consistent with our policy; that the Air Force on 10-12-59 advised that there would be no revision of any developments in this field of interest to us; and that there appeared to be no necessity for further instructions to field or instruction in agents' Handbook or manuals of instructions of our policy relative to flying sensors.

During the past twelve months only one complaint concerning flying sensors has been referred to this Bureau. This matter was turned over to the Air Force, both in the field and at the Seat of Government.
