

until their source and meaning have been satisfactorily explained. Although Mr. Teller's discussion tends to disprove the hypothesis that guided missiles or other vehicles are responsible, there is cause for concern of the continued occurrence of unexplainable phenomena of this nature in the vicinity of sensitive installations.

Captain Neal reports blue fireball visible from Santa Fe at 0830, 17 February 1948, and a yellow-orange cigar-shaped light at 1738, visible until 1808, 17 February.
