

KERWIN Unusual or Unexpected Visual Phenomenon. We saw light flashes.

I think all of us saw them. I saw them most often when I was in the sack at night with my eyes closed but awake naturally. They tended to wax and wane in frequency. They were numerous at times - two or three per minute.

QUERY You could isolate them to one eye, couldn't you?

WEITZ I would say mine were primarily in the left eye for some reason.

CONRAD You have to concentrate but you can determine they are in one eye.

KERWIN I did not. That was foolish of me but I didn't try. I'm sure they are in one eye.
